On **Friday 9th November** we will be completing our next whole school fundraising activity linked to our chosen charity for this academic year – Khalsa Aid.

On this occasion we will be celebrating Bandi Chhor in school and we will be asking children across Primary & Secondary to dress up in traditional Sikh clothing. However, as we will also be selling poppies in relation to Remembrance week, we have decided that the alternative to wearing traditional Sikh clothing would be to wear something red.

We kindly request that you make a donation of £1.00 per child. All proceedings will be donated to Khalsa Aid. Please can donations be made on Parent Pay - item displayed as 'Bandi Chhor – Khalsa Aid Donation'. This will be open from Monday 5th November to Friday 9th November. Alternatively, if you prefer to send in cash, then please do so on the day of the event with your child.

It is not compulsory for your child to participate by dressing in traditional Sikh clothing for this event and if they choose not to then they are welcome to come into school wearing an item of red clothing instead. Jewellery, sportswear and jeans will not be considered appropriate.
