Dear Parents/Carers

We are writing with regards to an update on our recent meeting with Department for Education.

Trustees attended a meeting at the DfE offices in Earlsdon, on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2018. The meeting was with Christine Quinn the Regional Schools Commissioner (RSC) from the West Midlands and her colleagues.

We can confirm that as previously communicated on the 4<sup>th</sup> October 2018, there is no risk that the school will be closing. The RSC confirmed that this will be a handover process and Seva School will be re-brokered with the approved Multi Academy Trust.

The RSC re-iterated that once the relevant internal processes have been completed Seva School will be joining a high achieving Multi Academy Trust.

We as Trustees are actively encouraging that the relevant engagement with our key stakeholders commences as soon as possible.

Briefly, in an update to the media coverage this week, we have complained about the article to the Editor of the organisation, which has caused unfounded and unnecessary distress and concern. We have in no uncertain terms informed them to take immediate corrective action.

We hope this letter provides you with peace of mind, we will be in touch in due course once the Department for Education has determined the approved Multi Academy Trust that Seva School will be joining.
