We would also like to thank you for your support as we continue to build upon the success of our recent Ofsted inspection. We are busy preparing for our forthcoming Key Stage 1 and 2 SATS examinations and your support in attending the parent workshops has been much appreciated.

We look forward to welcoming you to the secondary parents' evenings and the Year 9 Options evening over the next few weeks. It is a great pleasure to share that our pupils are on course to exceed GCSE expectations and we are very proud of their achievements so far.

Finally, we would like to update you on the current situation regarding re-brokering of the school. We have received positive news that the preliminary court hearing that was scheduled for Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2019 has been conceded. We are awaiting a date for a full hearing, which we anticipate will be set within the next couple of months. Therefore we can confirm that currently there is no proposed date for Seva School to transfer to Nishkam School Trust or another Multi Academy Trust (MAT).
