Mathematical Development

1. To read, write and order numbers 0 - 20.
2. To touch count objects to 20.
3. To go on a 3D shape hunt and take a photograph of what you find? Can you find a cone? Can you find a cube? Can you find a sphere? Can you find a cuboid? Can you find cylinder?
4. Barnaby Bear finds 8 shells at the seaside and wants to share them with his friend. How many shells would they have each if he shares them equally? How did you work it out?

Creative Development

1. Decorate an old shoe box to represent a place that Barnaby Bear could visit (e.g. seaside or forest, India)
2. You could use a range of materials and pictures from travel brochures.
