English:	Write sentences using and , but and because to join your ideas together. The sentences can be about what you did over the holidays.	Can you use the word endings -ing, -es and -ed to build a word bank. For example: jump, jumped, sing, singing	Talk to an older member of your family and ask them how they would have travelled from home to work, school to home or even from country to country. Write sentences about the information you have found out.
Maths:	Using the coins, 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p, how many different amounts can you make?	Find containers around your house that are less than a litre and more than a litre. Label each one, e.g. less than a litre, etc	Choose ten 2-digit numbers and write them in words, e.g. 35 - thirty five.
Science:	List and sort different plants (flowers, fruits, vegetables, trees, evergreens, deciduous or cacti)	Investigate where different plants like to grow. What do seeds need in order to grow?	Project: To build a 3D garden, forest or jungle.
History/ Geography	Draw and label all the jungles found around the world on a world map.	Name all the countries that make up the United Kingdom. Draw each countries flags and write some facts about each one.	Draw an aerial map of a jungle with a key.
RE:	Write 5 interesting facts about Vaisakhi.	Write a poem about Vaisakhi.	Design a card for Guru Amar Das Ji's birthday on 5 th May 2018.
Art & DT:	Look at how animals use camouflage to help them stay safe from predators. Can you make your own camouflage pattern?	Design an animal with a strange pattern. Try mixing the patterns from tigers, giraffes, leopards and zebras.	Make an animal of your choice using materials of your choice, e.g. play dough, paper, card or any modelling material of your choice.
