3. Find out about the author Roald Dahl and create a fact sheet about him
4. Create a 3D model of a chocolate bar using any materials you like
5. Design your own chocolate bar - draw and label it, describe what it is made of and why I should buy
6. Speak to as many friends and family members as you can about their favourite chocolate bar—create a bar chart to show the results
7. Chocolate isn't very healthy—write down five ideas for sweet healthy treats you could eat instead
8. On the map of the world provided show the countries where cocoa beans are grown
9. Write an acrostic poem about chocolate— each line starts with the letters that spell out the word CHOCOLATE
10. Write a set of instructions telling me how to make a chocolate cake
