Listed below are **TEN** tasks for you to complete by **Friday 18th March**. Children who complete each of the ten tasks to a high standard will receive a certificate in our Rewards and Celebration Assembly on **Thursday 24th March**. Children who complete outstanding pieces of work will receive a book token.

1. Make an information book to explain what life was like for children during World War II. Each page should contain a picture or a map and at least four complete sentences. All your sentences should contain at least one adjective, a connective and technical vocabulary (Vocabulary associated with World War II)
2. Design a poster to show why children had to be evacuated to the country
3. Create a 3D model of an Anderson Shelter
4. The date is Friday 8th March 1940 and you are writing a letter as an evacuee to your parents in Coventry
5. On the map of the UK show the main areas of the country where children were evacuated to. In addition to this show all the capital cities of the UK and all the main ports
6. Design a typical 1940s' evening meal for a family of four
7. Design a World War II ration book
8. Draw a timeline to show the main events that happened during World War II
9. Create your own 1940s time capsule
10. You are a radio presenter in 1944 and you are going to interview Winston Churchill (Prime Minister) Write down ten questions you are going to ask him
