Science:	HEALTH & SAFETY WARNING - This activity requires adult supervision. Learn to use an electrical appliance at home (a kettle, iron, vacuum cleaner, or another item). Ask someone at home to teach you. Stick in a photo of you using your new skill and write a brief summary about it.	Challenge your family to use less electricity for a week. Write about how you managed the challenge. What did you stop using and how did this impact life at home?	Make a flow chart to show what to do if the electricity stopped working. What could we do instead of using the electricity in our home?
RE:	Write a recount of how Sidhartaha Guatama became the Buddha. You may retell the story in your own words from the point of view of key people including Sidhartaha's father, his disciple or himself.	What is Nirvana Day? Create a Powerpoint presentation explaining the Nirvana Day and why it is important to Buddhists.	Design an information leaflet about Buddhism. You may choose to use a computer to create your leaflet (MS Publisher). You may want to include information on Buddhist beliefs, celebrations, facts, scriptures etc.
History or Geography:	Create a timeline of events leading up to WW1 and post WW2 and investigate how WW2 started.	To understand why evacuation was needed during WW2 and explore how evacuation was carried out during WW2.	Write your name using Morse code. Could you construct a message?
Art or DT:	Design a print for a wallpaper.	Draw or paint a picture that uses colour to demonstrate mood and feelings.	Using a plain white t-shirt or piece of fabric have a go at using texture by embellishing your piece of material.
