

YEAR 10 SUMMER TASKS

1) POETRY ANALYSIS

Ensure 'smiler sheets' for ALL poems have been completed.

2) LITERATURE REVISION

Create revision cards/posters/cue cards and revise for the following:

- i. Macbeth
- ii. An Inspector Calls
- iii. Dr Jekyll and Hyde OR A Christmas Carol

- **You must know the text and key quotes off by heart**
- **Approx. 10 quotes per Literature question**

3) SPOKEN LANGUAGE

- Prepare your 10minute spoken language presentation on a suitable and appropriate topic of your choice.
- Time = no more than 10minutes
- Candidates are permitted to use pre-prepared notes, PowerPoint, etc. For distinction, it is strongly advised, that you create a presentation of some kind.
- In September, each Y11 pupil will deliver their 10minute presentation in front of an audience. The audience members will each ask a question and the candidates must ensure they respond appropriately to these and feedback.
