On Thursday, 'Street Doctors' came in to deliver an Emergency First Aid course with thirty Year 8 pupils.

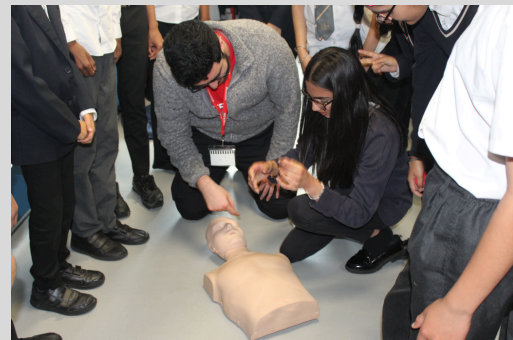
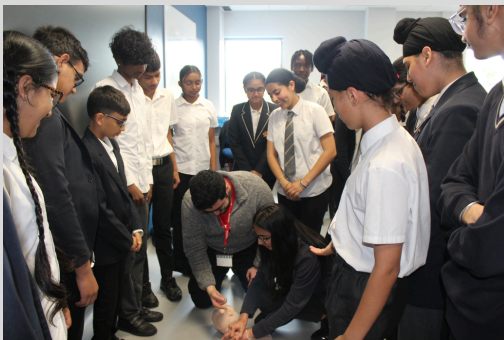
They learned how to deal with an unconscious casualty and a bleeding casualty.

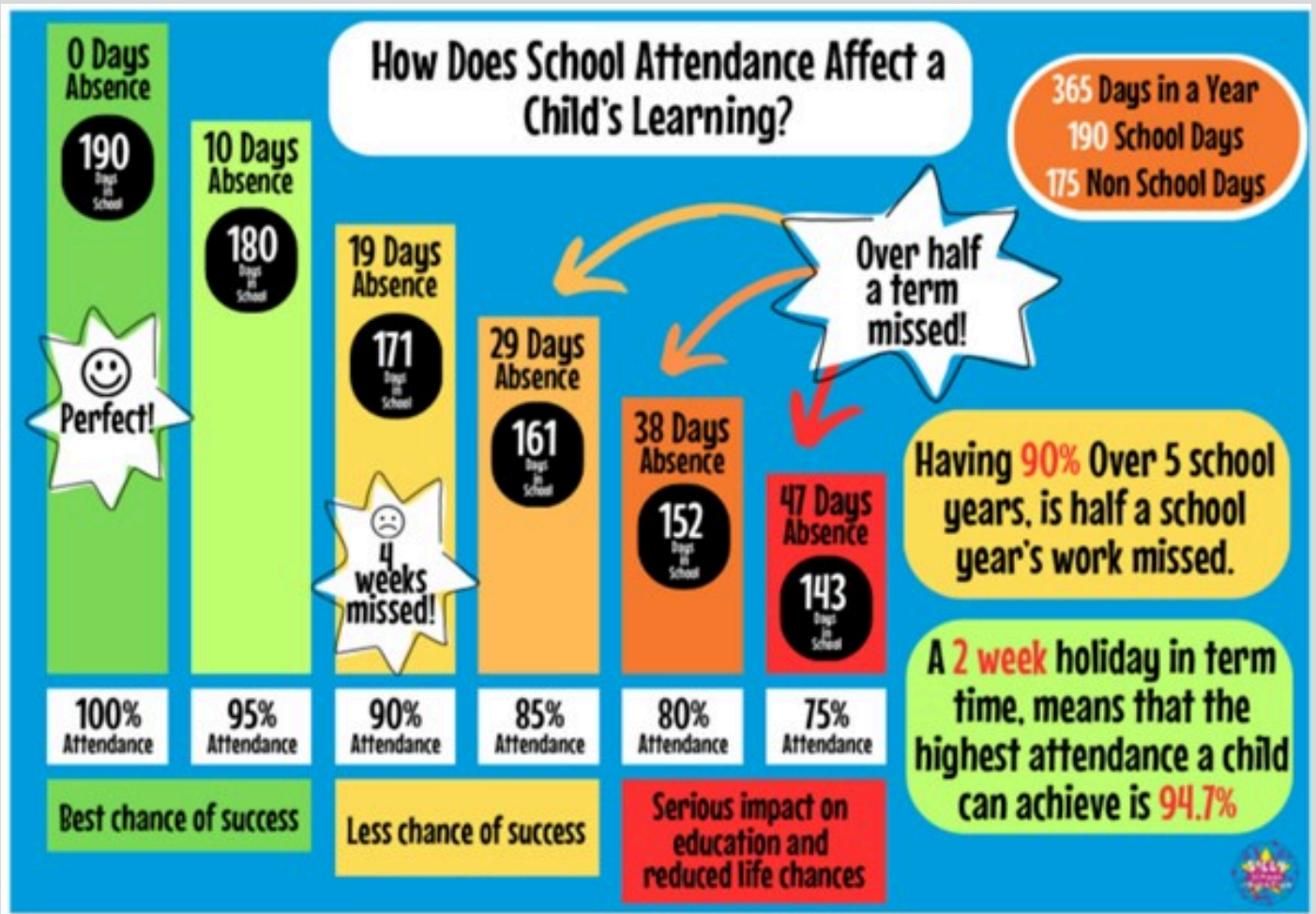

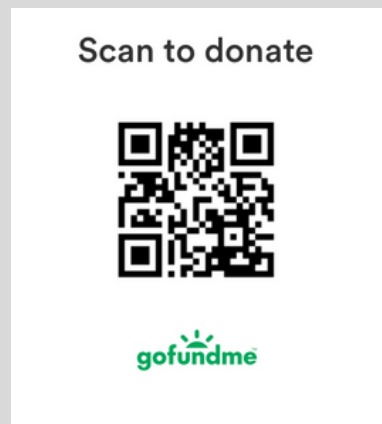

## Primary Drop Off and Pick Up

**KEY CHANGES**

**Drop Off**

- YR & Y1 **only** can park in Piri Building (Eden House), they must be then walked round to the rear of the building to their designated drop off.
- Y2 to Y6 can use the drop and go, not allowed to park in Piri Building (Eden House)
- Staff members will be at the drop and go location

**Pick Up**

- YR & Y1 **only** can park in Piri Building (Eden House), pupils must be collected at the rear of the building from their designated drop off.
- Y2 & Y6 must park on North View and walk to collect child(ren) from collection point at Piri Building (Eden House)

## Drop Off and Pick Up Locations

**PIRI BUILDING (EDEN HOUSE) DROP AND GO**

Like the current morning arrangements that are in place, we will be implementing a drop and go, shown below. Only parents of Y7 and Y8 will be allowed to park in the car park if they wish to stand wait for their child(ren) to the designated drop off. All other year groups will strictly only be allowed to drop and go.

**NORTH VIEW - PICK UP LOCATION**

Only Y7 and Y8 parents / carers will be able to use the reserved car park at Piri Building. All other parents / carers MUST park on North View and either walk into school to collect their child(ren) or meet for them on North View (to early secondary walk).

Parents / Carers must park on North View to pick up pupils at the end of the school day.

There will be NO vehicle access allowed into the Building Car Park (except for Y7 and Y8 parents / carers).





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## PE LETTER TO PARENTS



Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: 3G Pitch astro-turf boots and boot bags

As part of our ongoing efforts to maintain a clean and safe environment for all, we would be grateful for your support on adhering to some important guidelines regarding the use of the astro turf, suitable footwear, and the proper handling of trainers.

When using the astro turf, it is essential that students and staff wear appropriate footwear. Astro turf boots with rubber and non-marking soles are recommended to avoid damaging the surface and ensure their safety while engaging in activities. Before re-entering any indoor space, students and staff must ensure that the small rubber balls from the astro turf are thoroughly removed from their Astro turf boots. This helps in keeping our indoor areas clean and free from these particles, maintaining a hygienic environment for everyone.

**To facilitate the above, we would be grateful if you could ensure that your child(ren) brings their labelled astro boots in a labelled bag with their name to school on the days they have PE and on any days that require them to use the 3G pitch, for example, Sports Days. This will not only help in your child wearing the correct footwear through the day but will also prevent any crumb rubber pellets from being carried into classrooms and other indoor spaces like the Sports Hall.**

We appreciate your consideration in helping us to adhere to these guidelines. Your efforts in keeping our school environment clean and safe are greatly valued. Should you have any questions or need any further clarification, please do not hesitate to contact me.

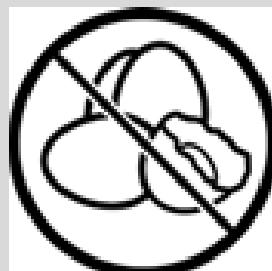
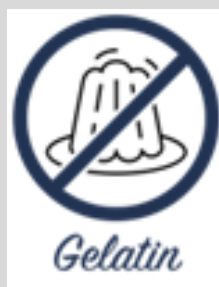
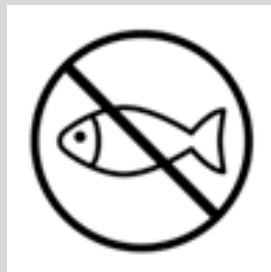

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## UNIFORM MATTERS



Only on the days students have PE can they be in school wearing their school PE kits. This does not include branded wear, hoodies or leggings. **In order to maintain the quality of the 3G pitch students using it must wear astro boots, no studs or bladed boots.** The astro boots they wear must be black to keep aligned to our PE uniform expectations. The images below show what the astro boots look like as they have a different grip to usual trainers. If students are not wearing these boots and the correct PE uniform they may be asked to sit out or a call may be made to you to drop the correct PE uniform off. The black astro boots are available to buy in most sports wear shops including Sports Direct.
