RE: Information about PE for September 2024

This letter is to inform you of the uniform expectations for PE and when PE will be taught on the either the outdoor pitches or Sports Hall during the Autumn Term 2024.

Primary and Secondary: PE Uniform and Footwear Expectations:

PE uniform must only be worn on days when your child has PE, please be aware of these days by checking your child's individual two-week timetable and annual pitches and Sports Hall calendar shared in this letter.

PE Kit Boys & Girls

PE Uniform and Footwear

When PE is in the Sports Hall or MUGA students can wear plain black trainers with their PE kit all day.

The 3G pitch has very specific requirements for its use and for this reason we must insist on the following in order for students to be allowed access to the facility. Your child will have to be wearing astro turf trainers suitable for the 3G astro turf pitch. They will also need to bring their labelled, black, rubber based astro boots in a shoe bag (which is also labelled with their name) to school on the days they have PE on the 3G pitch to change into. This will ensure they are wearing the correct footwear (see images below) for different parts of the

day and avoiding bringing black rubber crumb pellets from the 3G pitch into the school building. The facilities use timetable for the Autumn Term 2024 is outlined further in this letter.
