## Anglo-Saxon News

Friday 14 <sup>th</sup> March 878 AD	King Alfred Takes Revenge!	5 pence
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In the middle of the night, King Alfred and his Fyrd's, who had secretly planned a surprise attack were travelling to Edington on their horses. After King Alfred lost the Battle of Ashdown, which happened in January 871 AD, went into hiding in the forest of Somerset.

King Alfred sent messages to the Fyrd's to meet him at Stone Cross (which was a secret location) with their weapons. He announced that they had to prepare for battle and the Fyrd's were ready to defeat the Vikings.

King Alfred and the Fyrd's were charging into Edington and breaking the gates. A Viking warrior reported that he was fast asleep but suddenly he heard

horse hooves and gates being broken down. There were firing arrows and super sharp swords. All that King Alfred could hear was yelling and crying. Everyone was frightened and were all hoping that they would not die.

King Alfred won the battle and congratulated his Fyrd's. Alfred gave his Fyrd's lots of precious gold. He sold the Vikings as slaves and King Guthrum (the leader of the Vikings) pleaded for mercy.

**KEY CHANGES**

**Drop Off**

## Drop Off and Pick Up Locations

**PIRI BUILDING (EDEN HOUSE) DROP AND GO**

Use the current morning arrangements that are in place, we will be implementing a drop and go, shown below. Only parents of Y9 and Y1 will be allowed to park in the car park if they wish to send their child(ren) to the designated drop off. All other year groups will strictly only be allowed to drop and go.

**NORTH VIEW - PICK UP LOCATION**

Only Y9 and Y1 parents / carers will be able to use the reserved car park at Piri Building. All other parents / carers MUST park on North View and either walk into school to collect their child(ren) or meet for them on North View for early secondary walk.

Parents / Carers must park on North View to pick up pupils at the end of the school day.

There will be NO vehicle access allowed into Piri Building Car Park - (EXCEPT for Y9 and Y1 parents / carers).

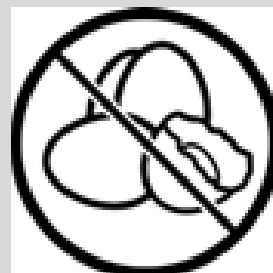
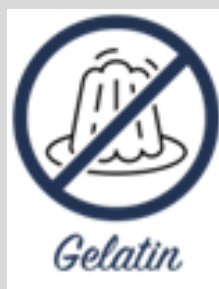
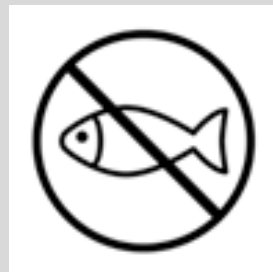

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## PE LETTER TO PARENTS



Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: 3G Pitch astro-turf boots and boot bags

As part of our ongoing efforts to maintain a clean and safe environment for all, we would be grateful for your support on adhering to some important guidelines regarding the use of the astro turf, suitable footwear, and the proper handling of trainers.

When using the astro turf, it is essential that students and staff wear appropriate footwear. Astro turf boots with rubber and non-marking soles are recommended to avoid damaging the surface and ensure their safety while engaging in activities. Before re-entering any indoor space, students and staff must ensure that the small rubber balls from the astro turf are thoroughly removed from their Astro turf boots. This helps in keeping our indoor areas clean and free from these particles, maintaining a hygienic environment for everyone.

To facilitate the above, we would be grateful if you could ensure that your child(ren) brings their labelled astro boots in a labelled bag with their name to school on the days they have PE and on any days that require them to use the 3G pitch, for example, Sports Days and football club. This will not only help in your child wearing the correct footwear through the day but will also prevent any crumb rubber pellets from being carried into classrooms and other indoor spaces like the Sports Hall.

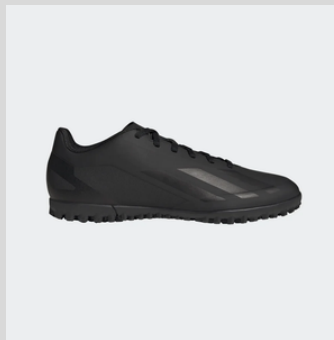


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## UNIFORM MATTERS
