The delivery of their speeches was absolutely phenomenal, and the standard of their speaking was simply remarkable! 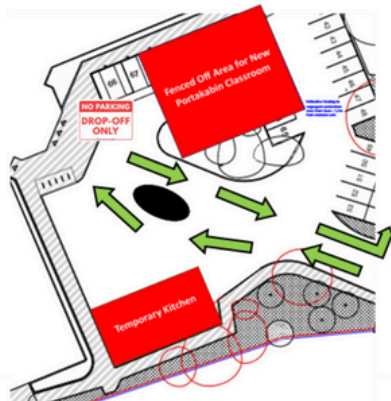

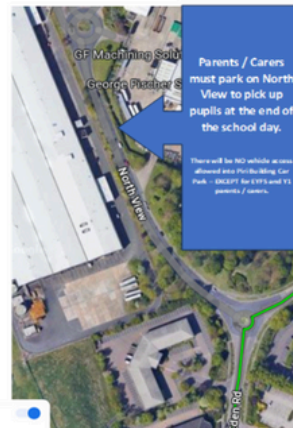
PIRI BUILDING (EDEN HOUSE) DROP AND GO

Only parents of YRS and Y1 will be allowed to park in the car park if they wish to stand around their child(ren) to the designated drop off. All other year groups will strictly only be allowed to drop and go.

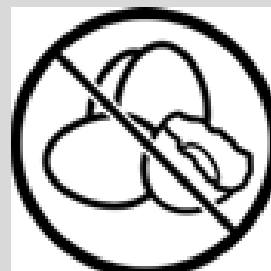
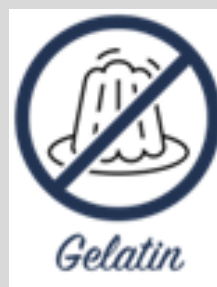
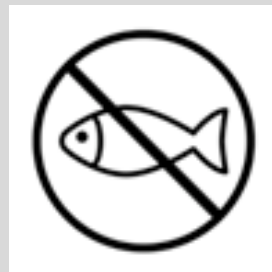

UNIFORM MATTERS
