## PE Footwear

A timetable for the units of work your child(ren) will be having on either the MUGA and Sports Hall or 3G pitch from September 2024 will be shared with you in a letter to be issued by the PE Department in due course. When PE is in the Sports Hall or MUGA students can wear plain black trainers with their PE kit all day.

The 3G pitch has very specific requirements for its use and for this reason we must insist on the following in order for students to be allowed access to the facility. Your child will have to be wearing astro turf boots suitable for the 3G astro turf pitch. They will also need to bring their labelled, black, rubber based astro boots in a shoe bag (which is also labelled with their name) to school on the days they have PE on the 3G pitch to change into. This will ensure they are wearing the correct footwear for different parts of the day and avoid bringing black rubber crumb pellets from the 3G pitch into the school building.



The following list of stores, although not exclusive, are known to sell the astro boots with the correct grip suitable for a 3G astro turfed pitch. Please note: metal or blade studded boots will not be allowed.

Please ensure every item of your child's PE kit and school uniform is clearly labelled with their name in a permanent marker. Please remind your child(ren) to look after their clothes and footwear items and remember to take them home.
